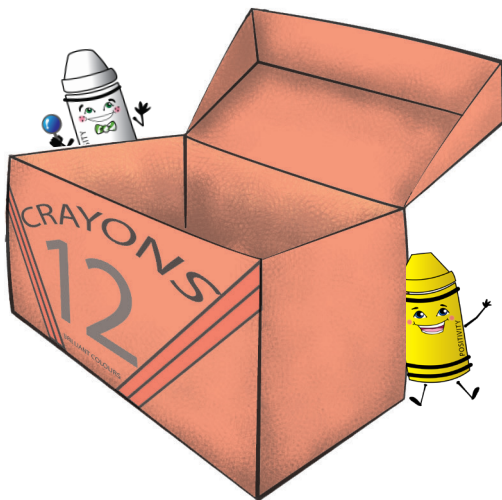

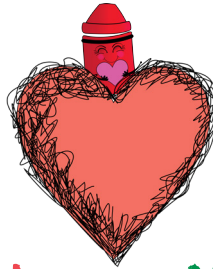

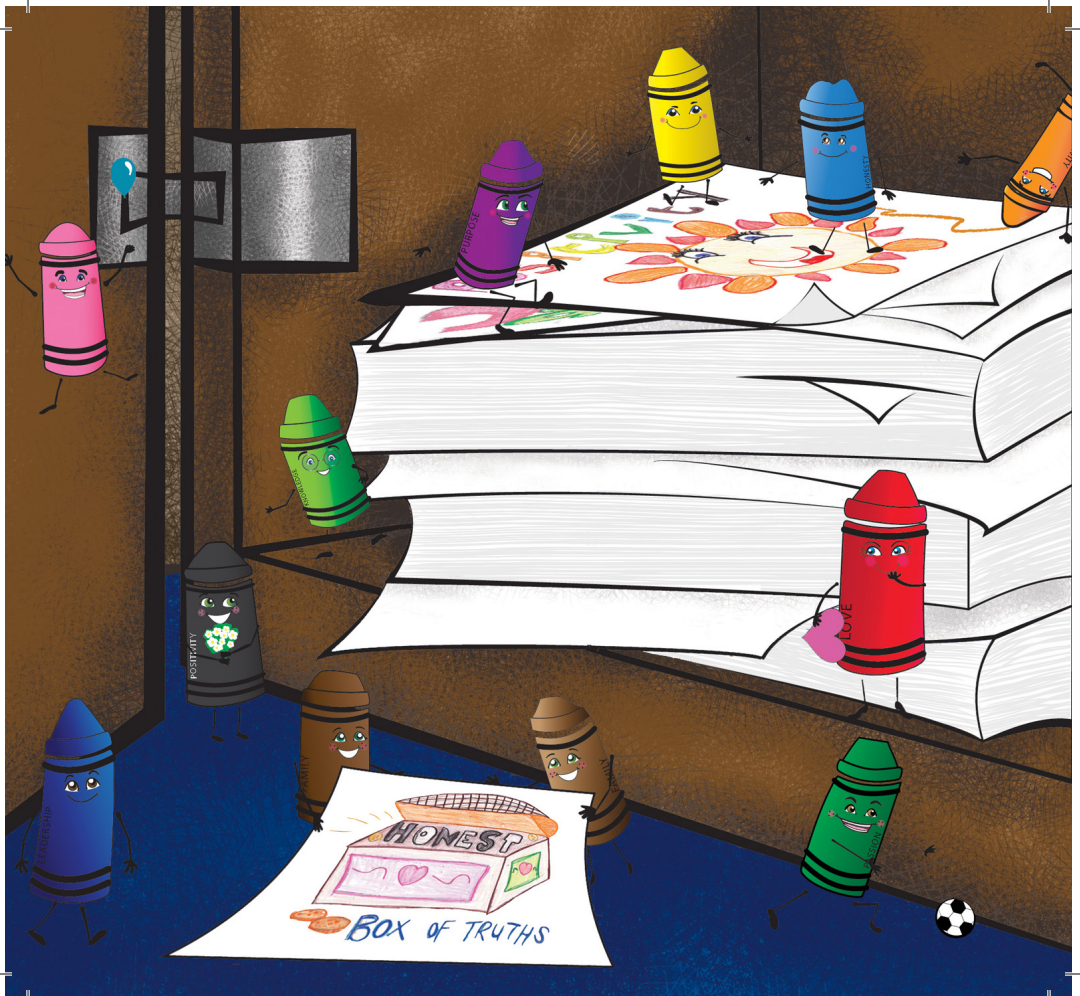

She looked around for them, but had no luck. Shrugging her shoulders, Buhle left the empty box on the table and ran to play in the garden with her brothers and sisters.

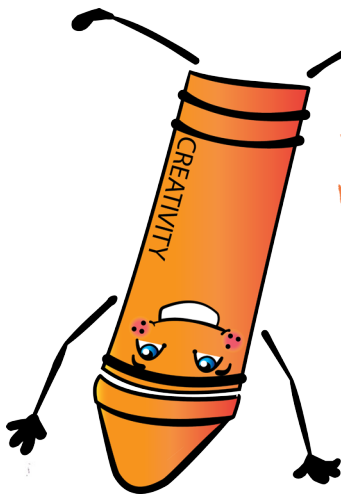


Meanwhile, hidden in a cupboard in the corner of the house, the magical crayons were doodling away and quietly creating very special messages for the children.

Melo's eye caught a message written in orange crayon next to her portrait. The message was addressed to her.

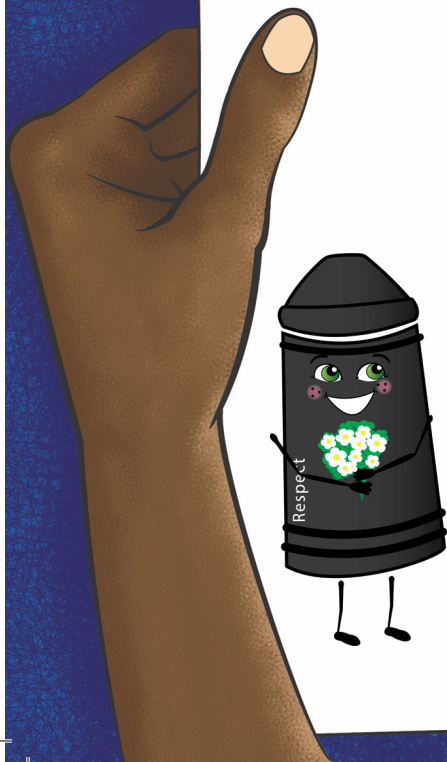


Dear Little Doodler,

She grabbed her message, which was next in the pile.

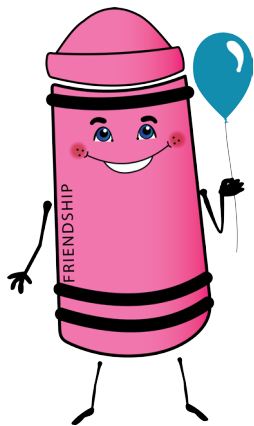


Dear Little Doodler,

and he found it written in blue!

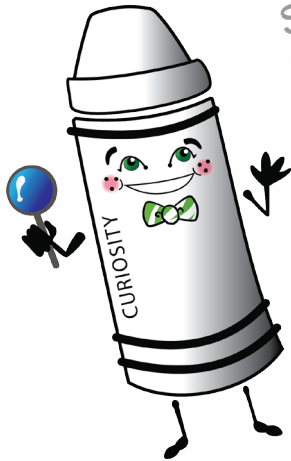


Dear Little Doodler,

Laura's message was especially for her!

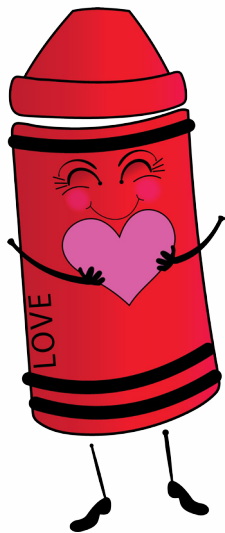


Dear Little Doodler,

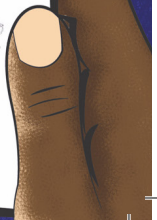
Bongiwe, one of the older sisters, looked lovingly at the smiles on her family's faces. She couldn't wait to share her message with them.

Love too!

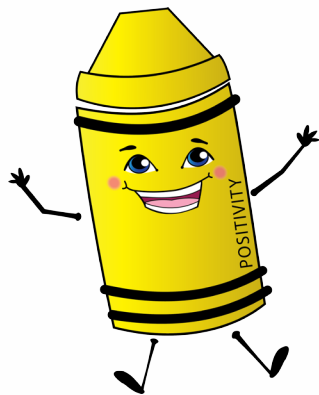


Christopher's face lit up seeing Amogelang's response.

take the time!

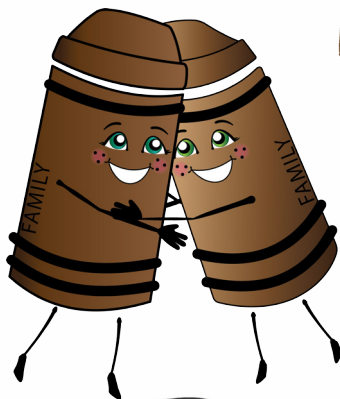

loved all the time!



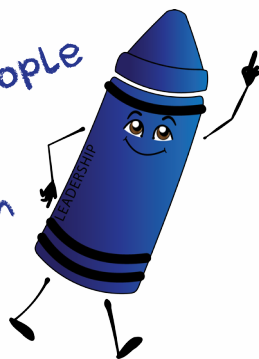

read her own message out loud.

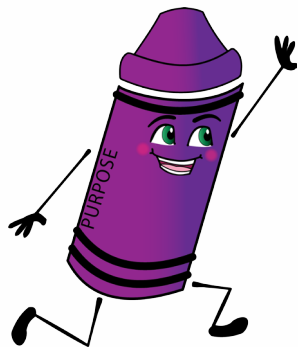
Dear Doodler,

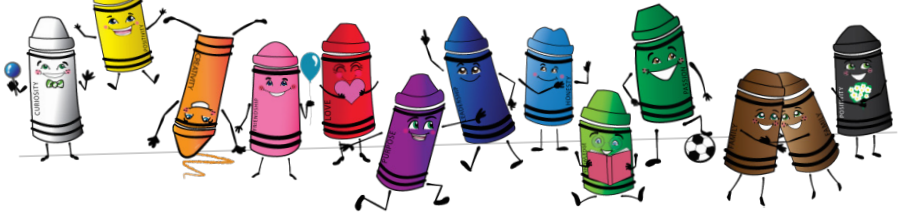
